Operation

- 1. Connect the appliance to the mains power supply.
- 2. Fill the outer container with approximately 600ml of water.
- 3. Carefully place the inner container into the appliance.
- Note: The inner container must NOT float, even when empty. If the container floats reduce the amount of water in the outer container.
- 4. Fill the inner container with hot soup and close the lid.
- Note: If necessary, remove any excess water from the outer container.
- 5. Set the temperature control. The temperature ranges from 1 (lowest) to 12 (highest).
- 6. The Power light will come on and the kettle will begin to heat up.
- Note: Kettle is not designed to heat food from cold.
- Reduce the temperature to maintain heat levels. To maintain temperature, BUFFALO recommend the lowest heat setting possible.
- Use a suitable implement to remove the contents of the kettle. DO NOT tip the kettle to remove the contents.
- 9. To turn the appliance Off, set the Temperature Control to '0'.
 - MARNING: Never move or carry the appliance when it is switched on or contains hot liquid.
